## ROYAL PARKS HALF MARATHON 2024 RBC CHAMPION AWARD

### 1 Eligibility

- 1.1 The competition is open to all participants who have successfully registered for the Royal Parks Half Marathon, presented by Royal Bank of Canada, taking place in Hyde Park on Sunday 13 October, 2024 (the "**Event**") except the Sponsor's and Promoter's staff who are directly involved with the competition, any staff of their subsidiaries or affiliates, prize suppliers, advertising/promotion agencies and any entity involved in the development, production, implementation, administration, judging or fulfilment of the competition.
- 1.2 The competition is free to enter and no purchase is necessary.

### 2 Entry

- 2.1 All runners registered for the Event with an individual fundraising page on [www.justgiving.com](http://www.justgiving.com) will automatically be entered to win the RBC Champion Award. You must be registered for the Event and you must have an active individual fundraising page on [www.justgiving.com](http://www.justgiving.com) linked to the Event. Team fundraising pages will not be eligible for the award.

### 3 Selection of a winner

- 3.1 The individual fundraiser with the highest fundraising total by midnight on 29 September 2024 will be selected to receive the RBC Champion Award donation. The total fundraising amount refers to the online fundraising total on [www.justgiving.com](http://www.justgiving.com) only and no offline fundraising will be counted when awarding the winner.
- 3.2 The closing date for the award is 29 September 2024.
- 3.3 The verification period will take place from 30 September - 02 October 2024
- 3.4 The winner will be notified by the Promoter by 07 October 2024.

### 4 Prize

- 4.1 The winner of the RBC Champion Award will receive:
  - 4.1.1 A £5,000 donation to the charity beneficiary of their JustGiving fundraising page.

### 5 Notification of the winner

- 5.1 The winner will be notified by the Promoter via the email used to set up their JustGiving fundraising page by 07 October 2024.
- 5.2 The winner will be awarded the prize by the Sponsor at the Event on 13 October 2024. Further details to be provided by the Promoter on 07 October 2024.
- 5.3 The winner must respond within three business days to confirm their:
  - 5.3.1 compliance with these terms and conditions; and

5.3.2 acceptance of the Prize as awarded.

5.4 If a winner does not respond to the Promoter within three business days of being notified by the Promoter, or if there is a return of any notification as undeliverable, then the winner's prize will be forfeited and the Promoter will be entitled to select another winner in accordance with the process described above.

5.5 The winner is not obliged to accept the prize and can only notify the promoter in writing if they would like to decline it.

## 6 **Publicity and personal data**

6.1 The prize winner may be asked to participate in reasonable publicity. The Promoter and the Sponsor will always seek consent from a winner before making use of his/her data for publicity purposes. Please see condition 6.3 regarding use of data.

6.2 The Promoter must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. If you object to any or all of your surname, county and winning entry being published or made available, please contact the Promoter via email on [royalparkshalf@royalparks.org.uk](mailto:royalparkshalf@royalparks.org.uk). In such circumstances, the Promoter must still provide the information and winning entry to the Advertising Standards Authority on request.

6.4 The Promoter will share the contact details of any winner(s) with the Sponsor to the extent necessary to allow the Sponsor to liaise with the winner(s) to organise the Prize. 7.3 The Promoter reserves the right to hold void, cancel, suspend, or amend the promotion where it becomes necessary to do so.

7.4 The Prize is supplied by the Sponsor. The Promoter reserves the right to replace the Prize with an alternative prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond the Promoter's control makes it necessary to do so.

## 8 **Liability**

Insofar as is permitted by law, the Promoter, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking

up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoter, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.
