



Residing outside the UK Ballot Terms and Conditions 2026

These are the terms and conditions ("**Conditions**") for entry into the ballot for participants who reside outside the United Kingdom (UK) for a public place in the 2026 Royal Parks Half Marathon (the "**Half Marathon**"). The ballot is run by The Royal Parks Limited (the "**Charity**"). Any reference to "**Ballot**" in these Conditions means the Charity's ballot for participants who reside outside the UK for public race places in the Half Marathon, and any reference to "**Entrant**" means any person who has applied for a public race place in this Ballot. These Conditions may have changed since you last viewed them.

1. Entrants to this Ballot must be (i) a person who is not residing in the UK and (ii) 17 years of age or older on the Half Marathon race day (expected to be on Sunday 11 October 2026). Successful Entrants may be required to prove to the Charity that they are over 17 years old.
2. Entrants are limited to one entry each. No bulk or third-party entries will be accepted and duplicate Entrants will be disqualified.
3. The Ballot opens on Monday 26 January 2026 and the closing date for receipt of entries is at 17:00 (GMT) on Friday 6 February 2026. Any entries received after the closing date will not be considered. Entries must be made via the Half Marathon registration platform.
4. The entry fee to participate in the Half Marathon is £66 (the "**Entry Fee**"), together with a £4.95 admin fee (together with the Entry Fee, the "**Fee**") which will be paid at the time of allocation (if the Entrant is allocated a race place). Please see Condition 6 for further details.
5. The successful Entrants will be drawn randomly from the Ballot entries received and will be notified that they have been allocated a race place via email, to the email address that they have supplied on their entry form, on Thursday 12 February 2026.
6. If a successful Entrant still wishes to enter the Half Marathon, they must (i) provide confirmation to the Charity, (ii) pay the Fee, and (iii) complete the runner registration form, including agreeing to the Runner Terms and Conditions, by 17:00 (GMT) on Monday 2 March 2026 (the "**Entry Requirements**"). Any successful Entrant that has not fully completed each of the Entry Requirements by the deadline set out in this Condition shall forfeit their race place.
7. There is no cash alternative to the race place and the race place is only applicable to the Half Marathon scheduled to take place in 2026.
8. The Charity is not responsible for any technical glitch out of its control that result in lost applications for a race place.
9. The Charity shall not be liable for any negligent misrepresentation made by it or any of its employees or agents.
10. The Charity reserves the right to: (i) vary these Conditions; (ii) disqualify any Entrant who breaches these Conditions or has acted fraudulently in any way; and/or (iii)

cancel, amend, withdraw, terminate or temporarily suspend either the Ballot in the event of any unforeseen circumstances or technical reason outside its control, with no liability to any Entrant.

11. By entering the Ballot you are giving the Charity permission to contact you about additional ways to run the Royal Parks Half. The Charity's privacy policy sets out how the personal data the Charity collects about an Entrant may be used. Our privacy policy is available at royalparkshalf.com.

12. These Conditions, and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with them, are subject to and governed by English Law, and any disputes will be dealt with by the Courts of England and Wales.
